

Daylight Savings Time begins Sunday

When we read the list of the saints recorded in Hebrews eleven, it is about the few who heard and obeyed God. These were the people of God – the people of faith. These were the people who ***“knew their God and did exploits.”*** [Dan.11:32]

God introduced the New Covenant declaring that He would ***“pour out His Spirit upon all flesh”*** so that ***“...they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest”***. The others would be busy building arks totally unaware that God is drying up sea-beds. Thousands of others would be

building monuments to the latest revelation while God with a few listeners would be moving forward - building of His kingdom.

And – let's face it - we ALL HAVE THAT SAME PROBLEM! While we may hear a new directive from the Shepherd, we tend to interpret it in light of yesterdays patterns. Or at best, we may make it an addendum to other ancient or more recent but well-loved creeds. Meanwhile religion is always close at hand to modify or quench the call of God. Since Abraham walked with God, religious spirits have continuously attempted to interfere with every one of God's children in an effort to rob them of that vital ongoing relationship for which they were designed.

So, as you set the clock ahead this Saturday, take a moment to tune in to the now-voice of God. The ONLY way to keep in step with God and His will is to be tuned in as a way of life. This has always been His plan in providing for the 'new birth'. **Nothing else works.**

And.... I think that He will be on Daylight Savings Time this coming Sunday.
