

DOING THE “**REASONABLE**” THING. [according to ‘Big Dave’]

Rom 12:1-2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service [of worship]. (2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Yesterday morning we did the “**reasonable**” thing when we presented ourselves as living sacrifices to the LORD. In view of what God has done [and is doing] for us [Chapter 11], - it is only “**reasonable**” to yield ourselves as living sacrifices unto God according to this revelation through Paul.

It is not **unreasonable** to die to the natural man and live a life totally inspired and directed by the living God.

This “ultimate sacrifice” is the only “**reasonable**” response.

Every day, every hour, every moment is simply another “**reasonable**” opportunity yield ourselves to God for HIS purposes for that moment. It is a only “**reasonable**” to yield the most glorious moments to Him. And in the most difficult moments of life is a only a “**reasonable**” to look to Him and yield to His purposes.

It would be “**unreasonable**” to do anything less.

Today each of us will have 8640 seconds in which to live our lives. Some of those seconds will be spent sleeping, eating, brushing our teeth, reading, working, driving our cars, and well... just living our lives like everyone else, but here is that “**reasonable**” request. “**I ...beg you to ... present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service [of worship].**”

Don't be conformed to this world!

BE transformed by the renewing of your mind.

Prove – discover – the good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Check in with God; He has a plan for your life today. Your identity and your destiny hang on how you respond to this “**reasonable**” request related to the 8640 seconds called “today”.
