

*Joh 1:1,2,14 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God.... And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.*

During this Christmas Season we celebrated one of the most awesome truths revealed in Holy Scripture

**Selah again!**

*2Co 5:17 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.*

*2Pe 1:4 For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.*

This ***“new creature”*** is a secondary incarnation....

We have become ***“partakers of the divine nature”*** accomplished and BEING accomplished as we embrace God's ***“precious and magnificent promises”***. This is the promise of every moment and every New Year!

May every day of this New Year see those ***“precious and magnificent promises”*** fulfilled in your life as His ***“divine nature”*** spills out into your world.
