

Isaiah 41:14 “*Don’t be afraid, people of Israel, for I will help you. I am the LORD, your Redeemer.*”

This morning let us hear the Lord Jesus speak to each one of us: “*I will help you.*” “It is but a small thing for Me, your God, to *help* you. Consider what I have done already. What! not help you? Why, I *bought* you with My blood. What! not help you? I have *died* for you. Listen, if I have done all this just for you, will I not do this little thing you are asking for? *Help you?* yes—yes—yes because of My love, I will ever be there for you! I *have* already done so much, and I want to do even more.

Just think----Before the world began I chose you! I made the covenant for you. I laid aside My glory and became a man---just for you. I gave up My life for you and if I did all this, I will surely help you now!

In helping you, I am giving to you what I have bought for you already. If you needed a thousand times as much help, I would give it to you. You ask so little compared with what I am ready to give.

Reality check for you:---- It is part of life for you to need, but it is nothing for me to give. **'Help you?' Fear not!** If there were an ant at the door of your house asking for help, it would not ruin you to give him a handful of bread crumbs and you are, in comparison, nothing but a tiny insect at the door of My all-sufficiency. You better believe this----**'I will help you.'**

*O my soul, is this not enough? Do I need more strength than the omnipotence of the United Trinity? Do I want more wisdom than exists in the **Father**, more love than displays itself in the **Son**, or more power than is manifest in the influences of the **Spirit**?*

“Bring to Me your empty pitcher! Surely this well will fill it, for My well never runs dry.

OK come to Me, gather up your wants, and bring them here—your emptiness, your problems, and all your needs. Behold, the river of God is full of supplies for you. What else is there?

Go and live in this Truth My child, **The Eternal God is your helper!**
 “Fear not, I am with you and do not be troubled----I, I am your personal God, and----I Am all you need.” (Spurgeon)(Victor)

Psalm 84 *O LORD God of hosts, hear my prayer; Give ear, O God of Jacob! Selah.⁹ Behold our shield, O God, And look upon the face of Your anointed.¹⁰ For a day in Your courts is better than a thousand outside. I would rather stand at the threshold of the house of my God than dwell in the tents of wickedness.¹¹ For the LORD God is a sun and shield; The LORD gives grace and glory; No good thing does He withhold from those who walk with integrity.¹² O LORD of hosts, how blessed is the man who trusts in You!*

Psalm 20 6-9 *Now I know that the LORD saves His anointed; He will answer him from His holy heaven*

With the saving strength of His right hand.⁷ Some boast in chariots and some in horses, but we will boast in the name of the LORD, our God.⁸ They have bowed down and fallen, but we have risen and stood upright.⁹ Save, O LORD; May the King answer us in the day we call.

Matthew 18:12 *“What do you think? If any man has a hundred sheep, and one of them has gone astray, does he not leave the ninety-nine on the mountains and go and search for the one that is straying?”*

John 14:18 *“I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.”*

John 14:27 *“Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.”*

Hebrews 13:5 *Make sure that your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, “I will never desert you, nor will I ever forsake you.” We can say “THE LORD IS MY HELPER, I WILL NOT BE AFRAID. WHAT WILL MAN DO TO ME?”*
