

Before I formed you in the womb I knew you. [Jer. 1:5]

This was God's word to Jeremiah, but it is true of each of us. God knew every one of us before He created us. Furthermore, every day of our life was recorded in His book before we breathed our first breath or lived our first day. BREATHING – breathing in and breathing out the ***Pneuma*** of God is the description of Genuine Christianity. Of course, we often resist God's work within. Often we think that we have a better plan and different agenda, but God continues to work His work in bringing us into perfection. Yield to HIM today.
